To some heritage places are seen as an impediment to economic prosperity and an infringement of their 'right' to build what they like where they want. In the past, thanks to the vociferous few, heritage has been labelled an irrelevant millstone around the neck of a forward-thinking and fast-moving society. But attitudes are changing.

In his talk, Richard Offen will demonstrate how organisations such as Heritage Perth are having a huge impact on the way heritage is

perceived in Western Australia. Slowly, negative attitudes towards the protection of heritage places are being turned into a positive recognition that we are custodians of an asset of huge economic and community value.

Through its innovative projects and high media profile, Heritage Perth is gaining a significant increase in public awareness of the importance of our heritage. This is demonstrated by a significant rise in enquiries the City of Perth receives for its Heritage Incentive Scheme and the number of people attending heritage events, such as the Heritage Perth's Heritage Days weekend, which attracted an estimated audience of around 20,000 people in 2010.
