The next FACET Forum features the Grand Canyon National Park (GCNP). FACET Chair, Prof. Ross Dowling, OAM, FACET Deputy Chair, Col Ingram and DEC Deputy Director General, Jim Sharp travelled to the Grand Canyon in September 2010 at the invitation of the US Park Service (USPS) and the Grand Canyon Foundation to view current park management programs in Grand

Canyon National Park and Canyon De Shelly National Park. The trio will present their impressions of Grand Canyon and other parks they visited.

The GCNP covers over 487,000 hectares, is one of the seven natural wonders of the world and attracts 4.5 million visitors pa. The park is home to over 1500 workers including a park workforce of almost 500. The GC contains outstanding biological, cultural and geological values. Eight native American tribes have strong connections to the park and the history of the GC is exceptional. Managing such high visitation within such a precious resource is a formidable task.

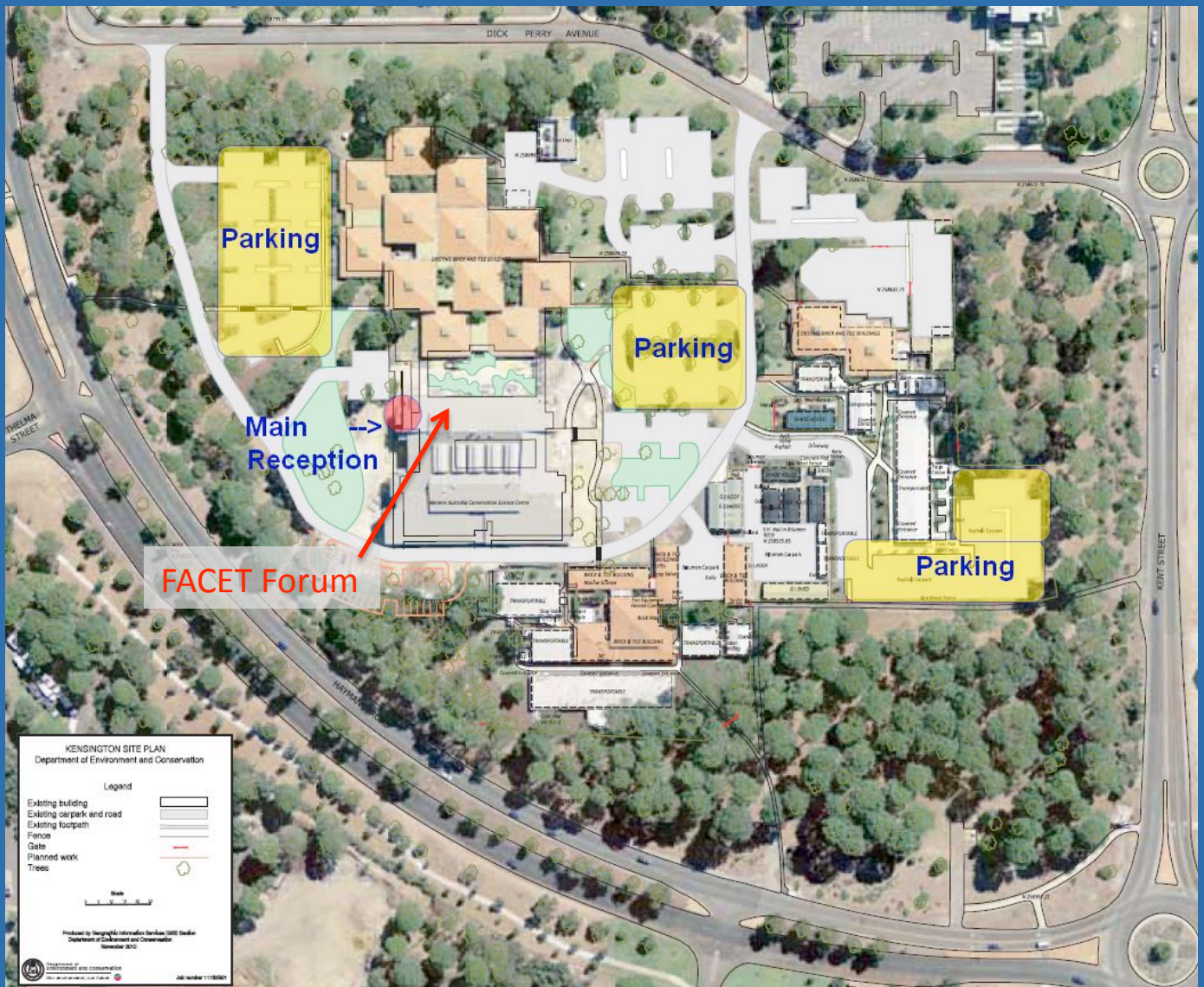
